What benefits do I get with my membership?

Your membership includes access to all of our services

- Unlimited access to your private named GP on weekdays
- Access to our Out of Hours Service on weekends & evenings with our duty doctor
- Home visits based on your clinical needs
- Access to our practice nursing services (may exclude costs of certain complex dressings)
- Writing of private prescriptions
- Provision of referrals to specialists
- Liaison with other health care providers on your behalf
- Completion of any insurance forms, medical forms, firearm licence forms and driver medicals
- Access to the Concierge Medical Private Health Insurance plan administered by HMCA (premiums apply)
- Annual flu vaccines
- Access to our support team for help with appointments, referrals and prescriptions





- Access to our 'Estate Package' for clients with large estates/large families or with domestic/estate staff
- Complementary drugs dispensed or administered by our doctors

Please note, additional costs will be payable for any medicines, consultations, treatment and procedures that are not provided by Concierge Medical; this may include:

- medicines that are dispensed from a pharmacy. You'll pay for the medicine plus any dispensing fee. Whenever possible, we'll coordinate with your NHS GP to ensure you continue receiving long-term repeat prescriptions on the NHS.
- tests that need to be sent to a laboratory for analysis will be paid by the practice and recharged to you on a monthly basis.
- private consultations with a specialist following a referral from us, charges to be paid directly to the specialist

Some of the costs above are covered by the Concierge Medical Private Health Insurance plan (not included in your membership), if you would like more information, please get in contact with one of our team.

Our pathology and laboratory fees

There may be occasions when you request certain blood or laboratory tests. Whilst we make no charge for the blood collection, which will be done at home, or the processing and interpretation of results, we do pass on the price of the laboratory tests.

By working closely with our partner laboratories we are able to significantly minimise these costs by grouping certain commonly required tests into 'profiles'. For multiple tests this will be the most economical way to proceed.

Please ensure you are made aware of the costs of any tests that are being conducted, and discuss any queries with your doctor at the time.

Complex testing

On occasions there may be a need to test for very specific or rare conditions, or a specialist has requested a wide array of tests. In this situation we can always provide you with a detailed written quotation from the laboratory to aid your decision on whether you wish to proceed. Please discuss this with your doctor, so they can arrange this for you in advance.

Our fees for vaccines

We are able to source and administer most vaccines that are licenced for use in the UK. **We do not charge for their ordering, storage or administration, but will make a charge for the cost of the vaccine itself.**

Whilst we can usually obtain vaccines quickly (usually within a day or two), it is often better to plan well in advance, especially for travel vaccinations. Please discuss your needs with your doctor or our nursing team.

Please note that due to the strict regulations around storage and administration, we are unable to offer Yellow Fever vaccinations, our team will direct you to a designated **'Yellow Fever Centre'**.

The prices reflect the **cost per dose and the price of a full course**. Please note, depending on your historic vaccine status, some vaccines may not always require the full course - check with your doctor.

The initial assessment of wounds is also included, but should this require regular, ongoing repeat dressing changes over a prolonged period, then we will make a charge for these visits.
